Condom
Distribution

Proven to Make a #SaferState

Research from the Center for Disease Control shows that condom distribution is an effective form of reducing sexually transmitted disease on college campuses.

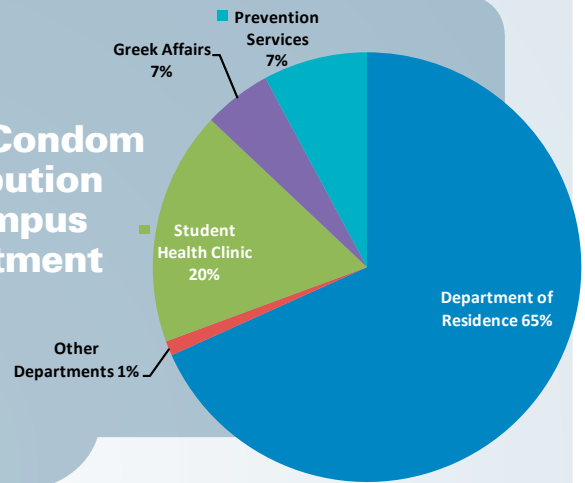
During the fall 2013 semester, Student Health's Prevention Services department distributed approximately **54,445 free condoms** on campus as a way to make Iowa State a safer place for our students. The total supply cost was \$4,024.

Online Condom Request Form for Groups

New in 2013, Prevention Services created an online condom request form for groups to use when requesting large quantities of condoms. Through the use of the new form and also the prior methods of ordering, Prevention Services responded to 64 requests for condoms in the fall. These requests came after the initial August Department of Residence resource fair distribution.

The condom request form is only for requesting standard, lubricated latex condoms. If groups would like to request other safer sex supplies from Prevention Services (i.e. dental dams, non-latex condoms, flavored condoms, water-based lubricant) they can email the office directly to arrange pick-up.

Individuals can also pick up free condoms provided by Prevention Services. This fall, 4000 condoms were distributed on campus during Free Condom Wednesdays and Thursdays.

- Free Condom Wednesdays from 10am-2pm at UDCC
- Free Condom Thursdays from 10am-2pm at the MU

Condoms are also available in the clinic and in the Prevention Services department during business hours. Student can get up to 10 free condoms per visit. Over 11,000 condoms were given out this fall through these routes.
